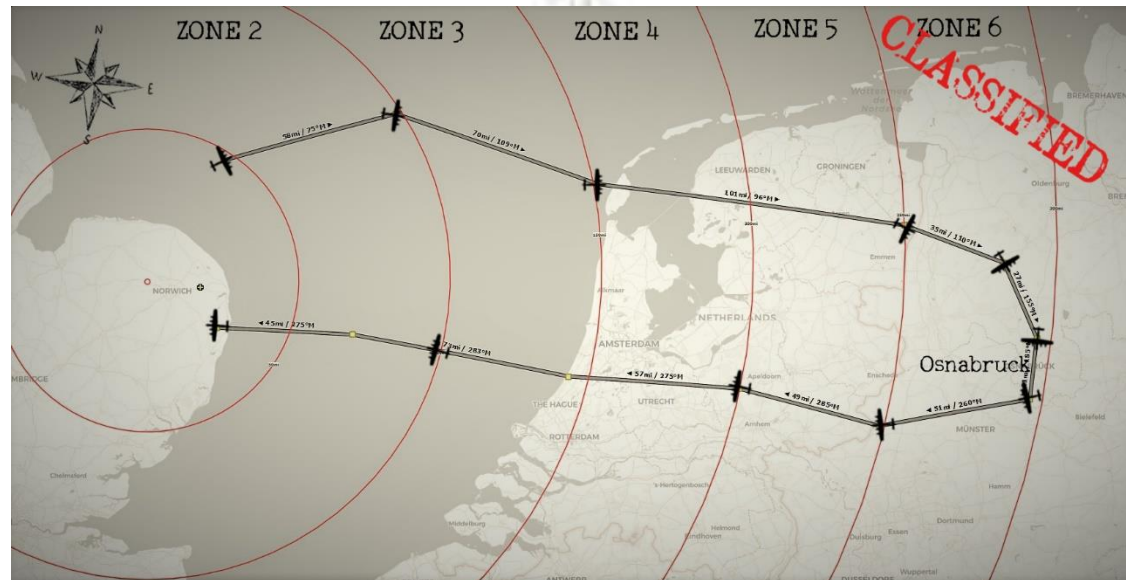


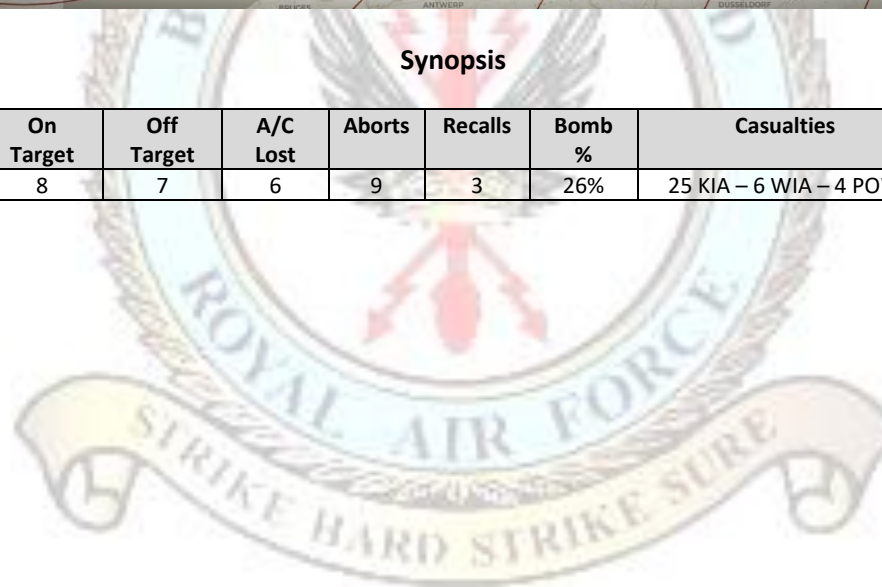

ROYAL AIR FORCE RAIDS ARE SMASHING GERMAN INDUSTRY



- Up to the end of the third year of the war, a total of 8,985 enemy planes had been destroyed, including those in the Middle East.
- From January to June 1942 the R.A.F. and R.A.A.F. took part in over 400 raids made by Allied Air Forces on Japanese positions in the Far East.
- Aircraft of Bomber Command have flown over 30,000,000 miles and Coastal Command well over 50,000,000 since the beginning of the war.
- One group of Fighter Command alone flew 2,000,000 miles during March and April 1942, the greater part over the English Channel or enemy-occupied France.
- In 31 days between 12th July and 11th August 1942, attacks were made on 26 days and there were only 3 periods of 24 hours when R.A.F. bombers did not operate.
- Bomber Command has destroyed between a third and a quarter of the whole of Cologne, the third city in Germany.
- Over 175,000 fire-bombs were dropped on Hamburg in 35 minutes on July 26th - 27th, 1942.
- The Royal Air Force are now using 8,000-lb. bombs in some of their raids on German industrial centres.
